
## **PAINTING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. #100 BASECOAT SEALER—Brush 1 heavy coat on fish.
- 2. #404 BLACK GREEN—Use to touch up any putty areas on upper  $\frac{1}{2}$  of fish. Also use to shade the markings on the back.
- 3. #702 PURE WHITE—Spray over lower ½ of fish from the bottom up, fading out as you spray up the side. Spray inside mouth, gill cover, lower jaw, pelvic fins, and anal fin. (Figure 1)
- 4. #403 DARK GREEN—Spray upper part of back, fading out ½ way down side. Spray top of head and cheeks.
- 5. #973 WHITE PEARL—Mist three, separate, light coats on bottom front ½ of fish. Spray jaw, gill covers, and pelvic fins. (Figure 2)
- 6. #404 BLACK GREEN—Lightly mist on top of back. Spray spots and markings on spiny dorsal, back, cheeks, side, and tail.
- 7. #372 CANDY GOLDEN YELLOW—Spray spiny dorsal at a 45 degree angle from the rear. Lightly mist on upper









 $\frac{2}{3}$  of pelvic, anal, and pectoral fins. Spray top  $\frac{1}{3}$  of side while angling down from above. (Figure 3)

- 8. #935 DEEP GOLD METALLIC— Spray top of head, cheeks, gill covers, and upper 1/3 of body with a moderate coat.
- 9. #672 CANDY PAYNES GRAY—Darken markings on head, back, and fins. This color works best when applied in 2 or 3 light coats, waiting 1 or 2 minutes between coats.
- 10. #503 SAILFISH BLUE—Lightly mist upper 1/3 of fish, top of head, and cheeks. Watch out for overspray on white.
- 11. #171 CANDY GILL RED—Spray leading edge of soft dorsal. Spray leading edges of pelvic, anal, and pectoral fins. Lightly mist where anal fin joins body. Spray vent, lips, and bottom edge of tail. Use this color very sparingly—a little goes a long way. (Figure 4)
- 12. #101 GILL RED—Spray a heavy coat on gills.
- 13. LIQUID CRYSTAL™—Spray fish with 2 moderate coats. Let dry between coats. Rotate fish to avoid runs if neces sary.
