

LIFE TONE PAINTING INSTRUCTIONS

1. #100 BASECOAT SEALER—Seal en-

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
2. #701 OFF WHITE—Spray belly, inside of mouth, lower jaw, and gill rakers. Mist lightly on lower sides.

3. #972 SILVER PEARL—Spray over all areas painted white except inside mouth.

4. #975 CHROME PEARLESCENT— Spray on lower sides up to where red stripe will be. Spray on gill cover. (Figure 1)

5. #603 NEUTRAL GRAY—Spray on top of head to cover epoxy areas. Spray adipose fin if it is artificial.

6. #453 TRANSPARENT DARK GREEN—Use to darken Neutral Gray areas slightly.



7. #931 IRIDESCENT GOLD—Spray top of head, back, and upper sides. (Figure 2)

8. #353 TRANSPARENT AMBER OXIDE—Spray all fins. Mist cheek lightly.

9. #452 TRANSPARENT MEDIUM GREEN—Spray top of head, back, and upper sides.

10. #101 GILL RED—Mix 50% Gill Red with 50% #100 Basecoat Sealer to make red more transparent. Very lightly mist on stripe area and on cheek. The stripe of a female steelhead is much lighter than the stripe of a male. (Figure 3)

11. #203 DARK BROWN—Spray spots on top of head, back, sides, and tail. Mist on lower jaw to darken slightly. (Figure 4)

12. #102 NATURAL FLESH—Spray inside of mouth. Mist on anus.

13. LIQUID CRYSTAL™—Spray 2 coats over entire fish.

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
